## Glossary

1. **Colleagues:** permanent, temporary, agency staff, external
2. **Contracts:** a legally binding agreement. Usually comprise of formal legally binding agreements, but can be informal agreements; both can be enforced through civil law. Includes: Contract Act, Sale and Supply of Goods Act, Sale of Goods Act, Consumer Rights Act etc.
3. **Supply chain:** \*\*Procurement, purchasing and supply, logistics, transport and operations management, within and between international boundaries
